Central Vietnam heat and rain shape market timing, walking and coastal stops.

Route covered

Arrive in Hue; Hue Imperial City and local food; Hue garden house and craft visits; Hai Van Pass and Cham Museum

Day 1 - Arrive in Hue

- Meet the local team on arrival in Hue and transfer to the hotel.
- Check-in and a short orientation are the only fixed commitments
- Imperial Hue and local food begins the substantive programme after the group has rested.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: None

Day 2 - Hue Imperial City and local food

- Use Hue's Citadel or a selected royal site to read the former capital as a landscape of water, ritual and residence.
- In Central Vietnam Food Craft Everyday Culture, the interpretation is tied to hue's imperial and residential food culture, the hai van transition and hoi an's market-and-craft story., while vehicle support and a shaded break keep the physical load realistic.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: Breakfast

Day 3 - Hue garden house and craft visits

- Move into Hue's residential landscape for a pre-arranged garden-house visit, where planting, architecture and family memory can be discussed without staging the household.
- The stop supports hue's imperial and residential food culture, the hai van transition and hoi an's market-and-craft story.
- and leaves space for tea or a hosted meal when the family is available.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: Breakfast

Day 4 - Hai Van Pass and Cham Museum

- Cross the Hai Van landscape with clear rest and photo stops, using the pass to explain the change between Hue's former imperial world and the central coast.
- Any Da Nang museum or coastal visit is limited to one focused addition so arrival at the next base is not sacrificed.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast



Route covered

Hoi An market and heritage walk; Hoi An craft workshop and cooking class; Departure

Day 5 - Hoi An market and heritage walk

- Use a market and one linked food experience to show how ingredients move through this region.
- The guide connects what is sold to household routine and regional history
- tasting is selective, hygiene is checked and the programme leaves room for the meal itself.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast

Day 6 - Hoi An craft workshop and cooking class

- Meet a workshop or maker at a scale where process and skill can be understood.
- Participation is optional, the visit is not staged as a shopping stop, and the guide connects the craft to local materials, labour and changing demand.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast

Day 7 - Departure

- The programme ends in Hue with a protected departure window.
- The group may retain free time near the hotel, but the route does not depend on a last-minute visit before airport transfer.

Meals: Breakfast | End of journey
