

# 6-Day Da Lat and Buon Ma Thuot: Coffee Highlands

A cooler, slower journey through Da Lat and Vietnam's coffee country.

Rain can affect farm access and road timing; harvest periods change what can be seen at producers.

**Route covered**

Arrive in Da Lat; Da Lat city tour and market; Da Lat farms and gardens

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## Day 1 - Arrive in Da Lat

- Private arrival assistance and transfer to the hotel, followed by time to settle in before a short orientation to Da Lat.
- The opening is intentionally light: a nearby walk or welcome meal may be included when flight timing allows, but no essential visit depends on an unpredictable arrival day.

Overnight: Da Lat | Meals: None

## Day 2 - Da Lat city tour and market

- Read Da Lat through its planned hill-city form, selected architecture and the produce economy visible in the central market.
- The day connects climate and urban history with how the city is lived now, rather than treating old villas as isolated curiosities.

Overnight: Da Lat | Meals: Breakfast

## Day 3 - Da Lat farms and gardens

- Leave central Da Lat for the cultivation belt where greenhouses, vegetable plots and flower farms make the city's cool-climate economy visible.
- A market or small producer visit is chosen for the season, followed by an unhurried afternoon rather than a second attraction-heavy circuit.

## Day 4 - Da Lat to Buôn Ma Thuột

- Drive from Da Lat to Buôn Ma Thuột through a changing highland landscape.
- The day includes properly spaced rest stops and, when timing is reliable, one agricultural or roadside observation
- it is presented as a substantial transfer, not disguised as a full sightseeing day.

Overnight: Buôn Ma Thuột | Meals: Breakfast

## Day 5 - Buôn Ma Thuột coffee farms and museum

- Coffee landscapes and local culture is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Follow coffee from cultivated landscape to processing and cup through one or two well-chosen visits.
- The emphasis is on livelihood, regional identity and changing production rather than technical jargon, with tastings adapted for travellers who do not drink coffee.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of the contrast between a planned hill city and a production landscape is the reason for the route.

Overnight: Buôn Ma Thuột | Meals: Breakfast

## Day 6 - Departure

- Departure from Da Lat is handled as an operating day rather than a final sightseeing slot.
- Breakfast, check-out and airport transfer follow the flight schedule, with late check-out priced only when it is genuinely useful.

Meals: Breakfast | End of journey
