Trip highlights

- The citadel as a planned imperial landscape
- Garden houses and regional food
- A geographic threshold between the bases
- Cham objects in a modern coastal city

Short-stay first-time and cultural groups.

Season note

Heat and central rain affect walking; autumn flooding can disrupt Hoi An.

Route covered

Arrive in Hue; Hue Imperial City and royal tomb; Hue garden house and regional lunch

Day 1 - Arrive in Hue

- The arrival plan in Hue is built around the confirmed flight, luggage and room readiness.
- No core experience is scheduled before the group is rested for Imperial Hue.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: None

Day 2 - Hue Imperial City and royal tomb

- Use Hue's Citadel or a selected royal site to read the former capital as a landscape of water, ritual and residence.
- In Hue Da Nang Hoi An, the interpretation is tied to imperial hue, the hai van transition and hoi an's trading landscape., while vehicle support and a shaded break keep the physical load realistic.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: Breakfast

Day 3 - Hue garden house and regional lunch

- Move into Hue's residential landscape for a pre-arranged garden-house visit, where planting, architecture and family memory can be discussed without staging the household.
- The stop supports imperial hue, the hai van transition and hoi an's trading landscape.
- and leaves space for tea or a hosted meal when the family is available.

Overnight: Hue | Meals: Breakfast



Route covered

Hai Van Pass, Da Nang and Hoi An; Hoi An heritage walk or Mỹ Sơn;
Departure

Day 4 - Hai Van Pass, Da Nang and Hoi An

- Cross the Hai Van landscape with clear rest and photo stops, using the pass to explain the change between Hue's former imperial world and the central coast.
- Any Da Nang museum or coastal visit is limited to one focused addition so arrival at the next base is not sacrificed.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast

Day 5 - Hoi An heritage walk or Mỹ Sơn

- Hoi An and optional Mỹ Sơn is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Choose between a focused Mỹ Sơn visit and a slower Hoi An day according to the group's interests and the weather.
- When Mỹ Sơn is included, Cham history is introduced before the site so that the sanctuary is understood as more than a photogenic ruin.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of imperial hue, the hai van transition and hoi an's trading landscape

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast

Day 6 - Departure

- Keep the final hours in Hue flexible until the onward flight is confirmed.
- Private transfer, luggage storage and any day-room requirement are timed around departure; no missed core visit is pushed into the last morning.

Meals: Breakfast | End of journey
