Route covered

Arrive and tour central Ho Chi Minh City; Central Saigon landmarks and political history; Chợ Lớn markets, temples and migration history

Day 1 - Arrive and tour central Ho Chi Minh City

- Private arrival assistance and transfer to the hotel, followed by time to settle in before a short orientation to old Saigon orientation.
- The opening is intentionally light: a nearby walk or welcome meal may be included when flight timing allows, but no essential visit depends on an unpredictable arrival day.

Day 2 - Central Saigon landmarks and political history

- Colonial city and political transition is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Examine selected urban sites where colonial rule, war, protest and political transition are still narrated in different ways.
- The day makes room for competing memories and avoids using museums or monuments as self-explanatory evidence.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of the contrast and connection between central saigon and chợ lớn.

Overnight: Ho Chi Minh City | Meals: Breakfast

Day 3 - Chợ Lớn markets, temples and migration history

- Explore Chợ Lớn through one compact cluster of markets, temples and association streets, linking the stops by vehicle rather than attempting a citywide sweep.
- The guide uses commerce and migration to support the contrast and connection between central saigon and chợ lớn..

Route covered

War memory and Buddhist protest sites; Departure

Day 4 - War memory and Buddhist protest sites

- War, protest and urban memory is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Examine selected urban sites where colonial rule, war, protest and political transition are still narrated in different ways.
- The day makes room for competing memories and avoids using museums or monuments as self-explanatory evidence.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of the contrast and connection between central saigon and chợ lớn.

Overnight: Ho Chi Minh City | Meals: Breakfast

Day 5 - Departure

- Departure from Ho Chi Minh City is handled as an operating day rather than a final sightseeing slot.
- Breakfast, check-out and airport transfer follow the flight schedule, with late check-out priced only when it is genuinely useful.
