Route covered

Arrive in Hoi An; Cham Museum and Mỹ Sơn; Hoi An to Quy Nhơn; Quy Nhơn Cham towers and museum

Day 1 - Arrive in Hoi An

- Private arrival assistance and transfer to the hotel, followed by time to settle in before a short orientation to Hoi An.
- The opening is intentionally light: a nearby walk or welcome meal may be included when flight timing allows, but no essential visit depends on an unpredictable arrival day.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: None

Day 2 - Cham Museum and Mỹ Sơn

- Cross the Hai Van landscape with clear rest and photo stops, using the pass to explain the change between Hue's former imperial world and the central coast.
- Any Da Nang museum or coastal visit is limited to one focused addition so arrival at the next base is not sacrificed.

Overnight: Hoi An | Meals: Breakfast

Day 3 - Hoi An to Quy Nhơn

- Read Hoi An through its market and former trading networks before one carefully chosen food or craft encounter.
- The group receives enough independent old-town time that the place is not experienced only through scheduled demonstrations.

Overnight: Quy Nhơn | Meals: Breakfast

Day 4 - Quy Nhơn Cham towers and museum

- Place Cham architecture and objects within a wider maritime and regional history before visiting the site itself.
- Interpretation distinguishes historical Champa from contemporary Cham communities and avoids presenting the tradition as a vanished civilisation.

Route covered

Quy Nhơn to Phú Yên; Phú Yên coast and fishing communities; Phú Yên to Ninh Thuận

Day 5 - Quy Nhơn to Phú Yên

- Quy Nhơn to Phú Yên is treated as a travel day with a clear regional purpose rather than hidden transfer time.
- The route includes well-timed rest stops and one or two selected observations that explain how landscape, settlement and livelihoods change along the way
- arrival remains early enough for an unhurried check-in.

Overnight: Phú Yên | Meals: Breakfast

Day 6 - Phú Yên coast and fishing communities

- Phú Yên coast and local life is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Use the day to connect fishing settlements, dry coastal agriculture and the region's distinctive geology.
- Viewpoints are selected for context and access, with time for a local meal and no pressure to turn every coastal stop into an activity.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of da nang's collection, mỹ sơn or an equivalent early cham chapter, hình đình towers and contemporary ninh thuận

Overnight: Phú Yên | Meals: Breakfast

Day 7 - Phú Yên to Ninh Thuận

- Phú Yên to Ninh Thuận is treated as a travel day with a clear regional purpose rather than hidden transfer time.
- The route includes well-timed rest stops and one or two selected observations that explain how landscape, settlement and livelihoods change along the way
- arrival remains early enough for an unhurried check-in.

Day 8 - Ninh Thuận Cham villages and landscape

- Ninh Thuận culture and landscape is used to advance the route's central question rather than add another checklist stop.
- Use the day to connect fishing settlements, dry coastal agriculture and the region's distinctive geology.
- Viewpoints are selected for context and access, with time for a local meal and no pressure to turn every coastal stop into an activity.
- For this journey, the day is kept in service of da nang's collection, mỹ sơn or an equivalent early cham chapter, hình đình towers and contemporary ninh thuận

Overnight: Ninh Thuận | Meals: Breakfast

Day 9 - Ninh Thuận to Cam Ranh

- Ninh Thuận to Cam Ranh is treated as a travel day with a clear regional purpose rather than hidden transfer time.
- The route includes well-timed rest stops and one or two selected observations that explain how landscape, settlement and livelihoods change along the way
- arrival remains early enough for an unhurried check-in.

Overnight: Cam Ranh | Meals: Breakfast

Day 10 - Departure

- Departure from Hoi An is handled as an operating day rather than a final sightseeing slot.
- Breakfast, check-out and airport transfer follow the flight schedule, with late check-out priced only when it is genuinely useful.
